In the second part of the webinar, he focused on the key components of a teaching portfolio, which are teaching philosophy, resume or curriculum vitae (CV), lesson plans, instructional materials and sample assignments or assessments.

During this webinar, participants gained a comprehensive understanding of the purpose and benefits of a teaching portfolio, and they learned practical strategies for organizing and presenting their materials effectively.

Key Components of a Teaching Portfolio

Teaching philosophy statement

A clear and well-articulated statement that outlines your beliefs, values, and goals as a teacher

Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV)

A comprehensive and well-organized document that summarizes your teaching experiences, credentials, and qualifications

Lesson plans and instructional materials

A selection of representative lesson plans and instructional materials that demonstrate your teaching strategies and approaches

Sample assignments and assessments

A variety of student work samples and assessment artifacts that demonstrate student learning and progress.

What is a "Portfolio"?

A **portfolio** is a purposeful collection of documents, artifacts, or samples of work that showcases an individual's skills, experiences, accomplishments, and growth in a particular domain or field.



WORKSHOP “MANAGING OBE IMPLEMENTATION USING OBE ONLINE SYSTEM”



This workshop was held on 24th July 2023 and conducted by Mr. Adzly Anuar from Curriculum Enhancement Unit, CAFEL. The workshop was attended by more than 10 Head of Programs (HoP) /Head of Units (HoU) from all colleges.

It aimed to reinforce the understanding and implementation of Outcome-Based Education (OBE) at UNITEN, clarifying the roles and responsibilities of Heads of Programs (HoP) and Heads of Units (HoU) in utilizing the OBEOS system for OBE implementation.

Furthermore, the workshop aimed to provide explanations and guidance on using the main functions of OBEOS, such as defining Program Educational Objectives (PEO) and Program Outcomes (PO), collecting course coordinator input, tracking assessment scores, and reviewing achievement results.



WEBINAR “BRIGHTEN UP YOUR LMS SERIES 2: HOW TO CREATE TEACHING AND LEARNING ACTIVITIES EFFECTIVELY”

This webinar was the second out of 3 of Brighten Up Your LMS series workshop. This webinar was held on 16th August 2023 and conducted by Dr. Jehana Ermy Jamaluddin via Microsoft Teams. The webinar was attended by more than 30 participants.

In the webinar, Dr. Jehana Ermy Jamaluddin emphasized the importance of aligning teaching activities with learning outcomes and assessments. She discussed how to create interactive activities using the built-in Brighten activity types and stressed their significance in engaging students in active learning.

Additionally, she highlighted the importance of using media and multimedia and incorporating them using tools like Padlet, Mentimeter, and Panopto. She also emphasized the value of providing feedback and assessments to students.

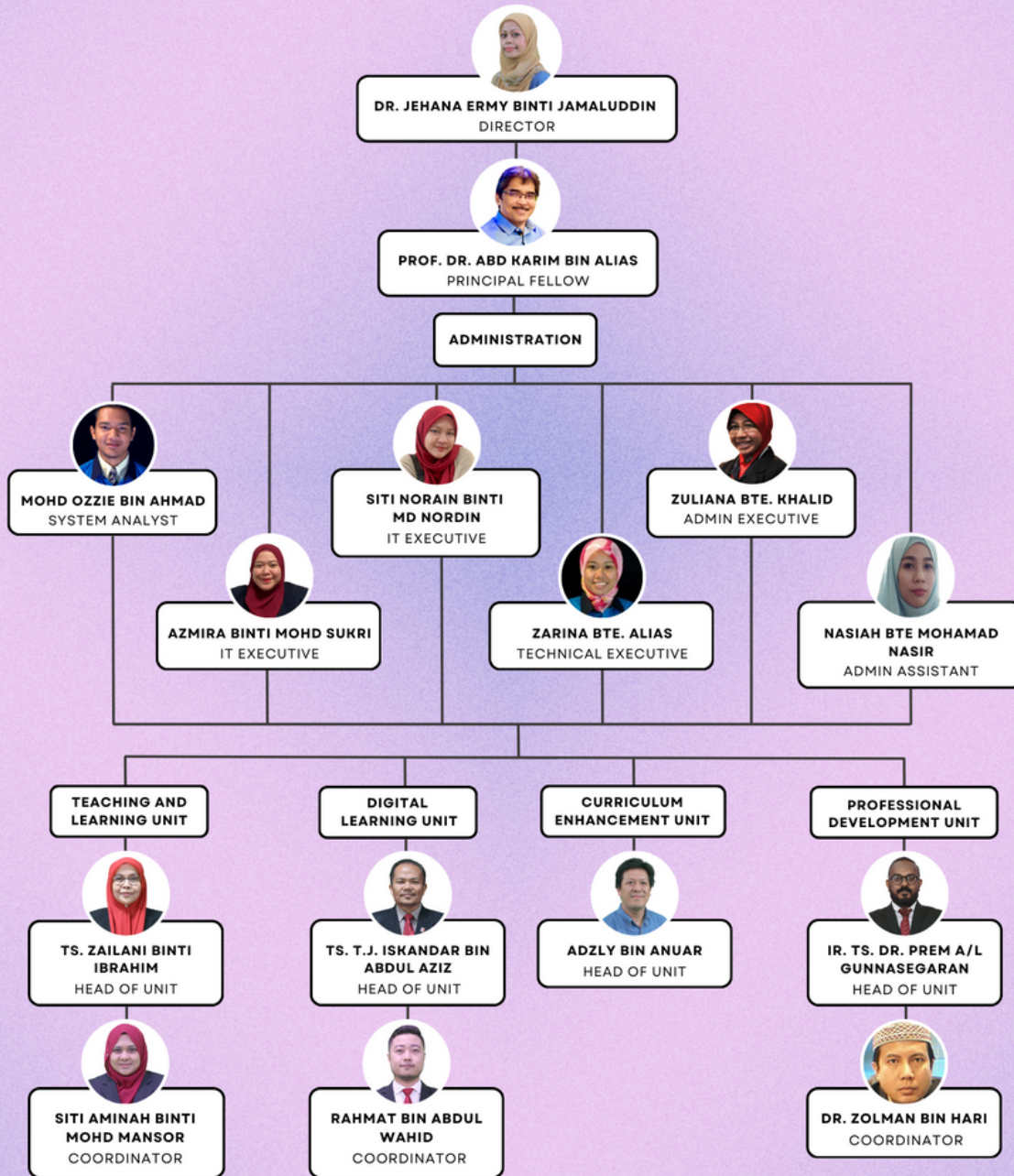
