Sharing Session with Inspirational Lecturers



TLC has organized a sharing session by inspiring lecturers in “Tea With TLC” on the 13th December 2019. The session being interactive and casual, celebrates teaching excellence at the university level. The speakers who were invited to share their experience were Mr. Muhammad Hafizan Bin Abd Hamid (CES), Ms. Nur Aimi Syaqlah Aziz (CCI) and Mr. Mohd. Fadlihisyam Ishak (COE). Mr. Muhammad Hafizan teaches Islamic Studies and is seconded to the Tahfiz unit while Mr. Mohd. Fadlihisyam teaches calculus and mathematics for diploma and foundation. The session highlighted some important teaching and learning aspects in UNITEN context.

Among the gist of the session are:

- Inspirational lecturers facilitate: they do not teach but they coach and promote teamwork among students
- Be friends with students and do not distant yourselves
- Treat students as adults; with control and barrier when necessary
- Punishment needs to be appropriate to the offence
- Teach with confidence
- Preparation is key: break learning into small chunks and plan milestones with students who need extra help
- Give students a sense of achievement so that they feel appreciated
- Use human discretion with student problems; treat students personally and give them space
- Be sensitive to the needy; ask them if they are doing OK
- With flipped learning, materials need to be prepared before class; with goals and learning outcomes
- Motivate reward-focused learning
- Always do the best for every goal

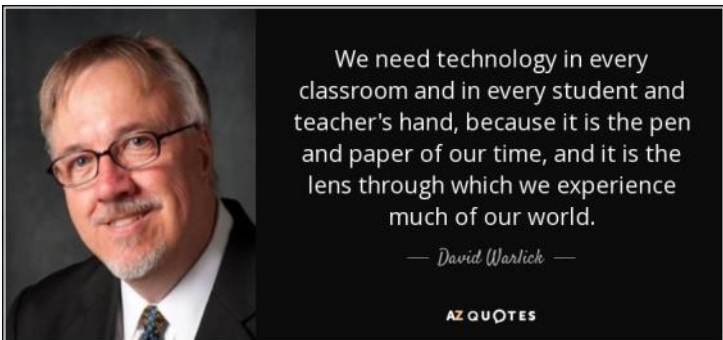
