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UNITEN TEACHING AND LEARNING FEST (UTLF2019) OFFICIATING CEREMONY



UNITEN Teaching and Learning Fest 2019 (UTLF2019) is a continuation to International Conference on Teaching and Learning in Education (ICTLE) held in 2013 and 2016. The one-day symposium held on 19 September 2019 at the Administration Building Theatre was to serve as an internal academic sharing platform in teaching and learning.

Yang Berbahagia Prof. Dato' Ir. Dr. Kamal Nasharuddin Mustapha, the Vice Chancellor of UNITEN, officiated the opening of UTLF2019. In his officiating speech, he urged UNITEN academics to be abreast, or to be more advance with technology in teaching and learning, as education is rapidly changing. He also added that UNITEN since then is funded by TNB to promote blended learning and emphasized the significance of utilizing the facilities (i.e. PBL rooms, green studio for recording, self-access studio), and academics to participate in TLC training courses. He hoped that UTLF2019 becomes a platform for collaboration of teaching projects across disciplines and colleges.

UTLF2019 hosted a forum on sharing teaching and learning best practices and has accepted 20 papers for presentation in four sessions.

UNITEN TEACHING AND LEARNING FEST (UTLF2019) FORUM ON TEACHING EXCELLENCE

The poster features logos for UNITEN (The Energy University), TLC (Teaching and Learning Centre), and UTLF (Uniten Teaching & Learning Fest). The main title is 'FORUM: ENRICHING LEARNING EXPERIENCE WITH BLENDED LEARNING'. The event is scheduled for 19th September 2019, from 0930 to 1030, at the Admin Theatre. The moderator is Dr. Thaharah (TLC). The three panelists are Dr. Rosmiza (CES), Pn. Karmila (COE), and Pn. Nurshuhaida (CES).

A special forum session on the UTLF2019 symposium theme “Enriching Learning Experience with Blended Learning” was held after the officiating event. The exciting forum featured three lecturers who had outstanding teaching evaluation scores from the past two semesters. The panels were Dr. Rosmiza Mokhtar (CES), Ms. Karmila Kamil (COE), and Ms. Nurshuhaida Mohd Shokri (CES). They shared their experiences, thoughts and ideas on best practices in teaching and learning. These are of equal importance in the enhancement of teaching and learning



in higher education. This forum provided a stimulating environment for UNITEN academics to learn about innovative approaches, and to meet colleagues and share ideas. The forum also reflected on some of the hot topics in managing millennial students. Among the topics discussed among the panels were how teachers becoming designers of learning experience, how they prepare their students for Education 4.0, and future skills with reference to the World Economic Forum Top 10 Skills, and how they practice teaching with technology. The forum was moderated by Dr. Thaharah Hila-luddin, Director of Teaching and Learning Centre.

UNITEN TEACHING AND LEARNING FEST (UTLF2019) PAPER PRESENTATIONS

Among the objectives of this symposium is to provide a platform for BL-passionate lecturers to share BL innovative ideas and classroom practices. Therefore, the paper presentations offered all lecturers in particular, to present their work further at teaching fests and conferences at other universities. Apart from promoting sharing of blended learning experiences, UTLF2019 served as a stepping stone towards the development of publications on teaching and learning practices.

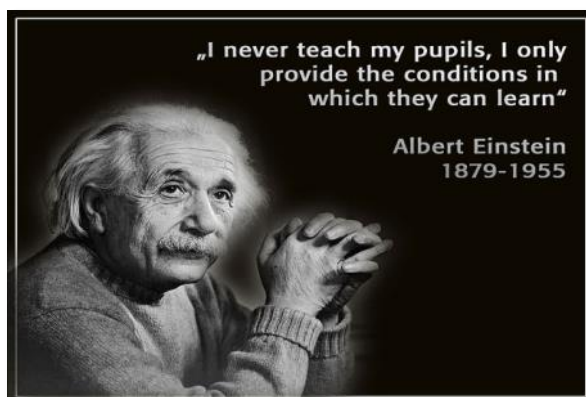

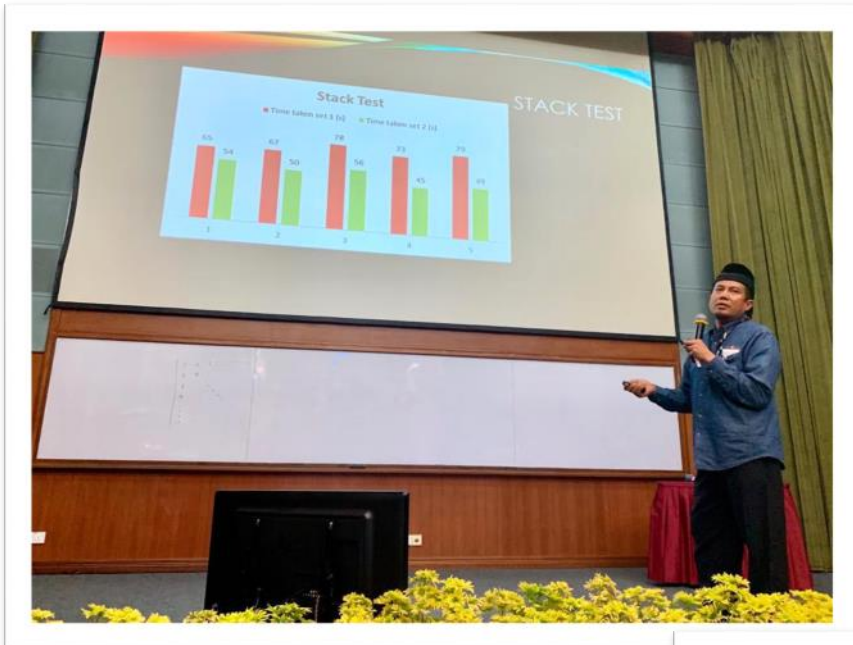

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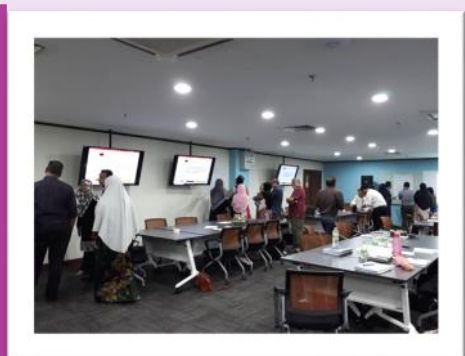
EFFECTIVE IMPLEMENTATIONS OF ACTIVE LEARNING WORKSHOP
