Introduction to PIP3



Program Intensif Persijilan Pengajaran dan Pembelajaran (PIP3) UNITEN is a revised version of Postgraduate Diploma in Education at UNITEN that was conducted between 2012-2017. PIP3 is a 10-day intensive program that requires full attendance to be awarded a certificate of completion. It is an adaptation of KPT's program module for the professional training of lecturers at IPTA. PIP3 is initially designed for beginner lecturer at UNITEN. It is now open to all. The objective of PIP3 is to equip UNITEN's lecturers with professional skills in teaching.

UNITEN Pilot Courses

The BOLD2025 Blended Learning Committee has selected 36 courses with 49 lecturers to be part of its pilot implementation since 2016. The courses are mostly in students' first and second years of study with the aim to enhance students' learning experiences at basics and foundation levels. College of Engineering (COE) leads with 53% (26 staffs) appointed as pilot lecturers, College of Foundation and General Studies (CFGS) with 23% (11 staffs), College of Accounting and Business Studies (COBA) with 14% (7 staffs), and College of Computer Science and Information Technology (CSIT) with 10% (5 staffs). The pilot lecturers are soon to be called **AGENTS** to further inspire, and to help assist other staffs undertaking BL in their current courses.

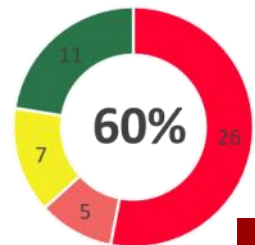

The number of courses adopting BL has exceeded the 22 minimum specified by TNB. Based on analytics obtained from TLC, many of the pilot courses improved over the semesters, and over the years; indicating that the BL initiative indirectly increased the students' performance and class engagement.

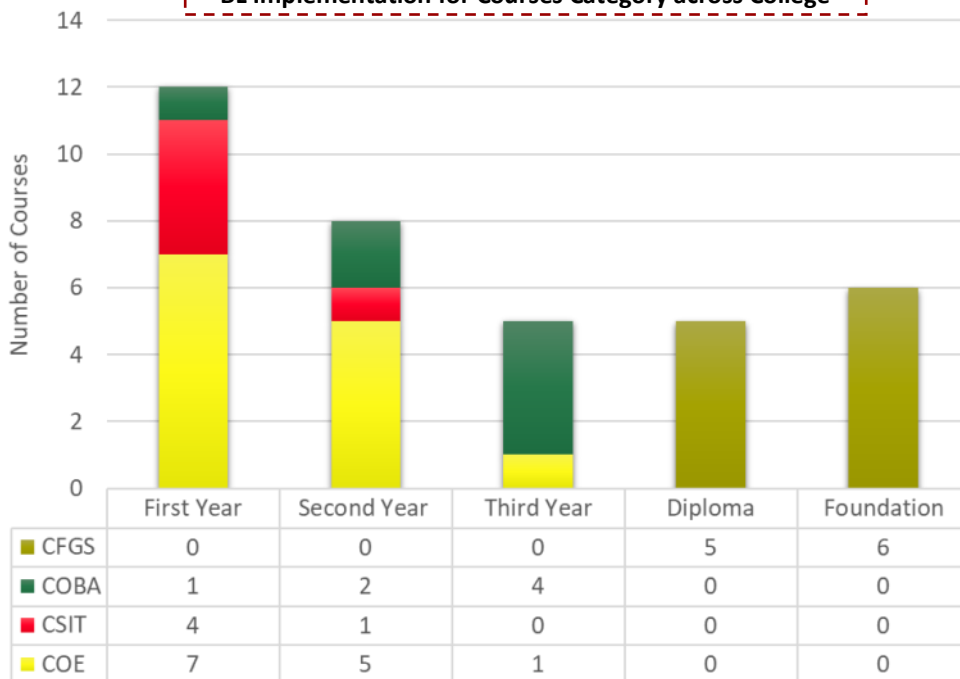
Thus, it is decided that the BL initiative is to include more lecturers across the colleges.

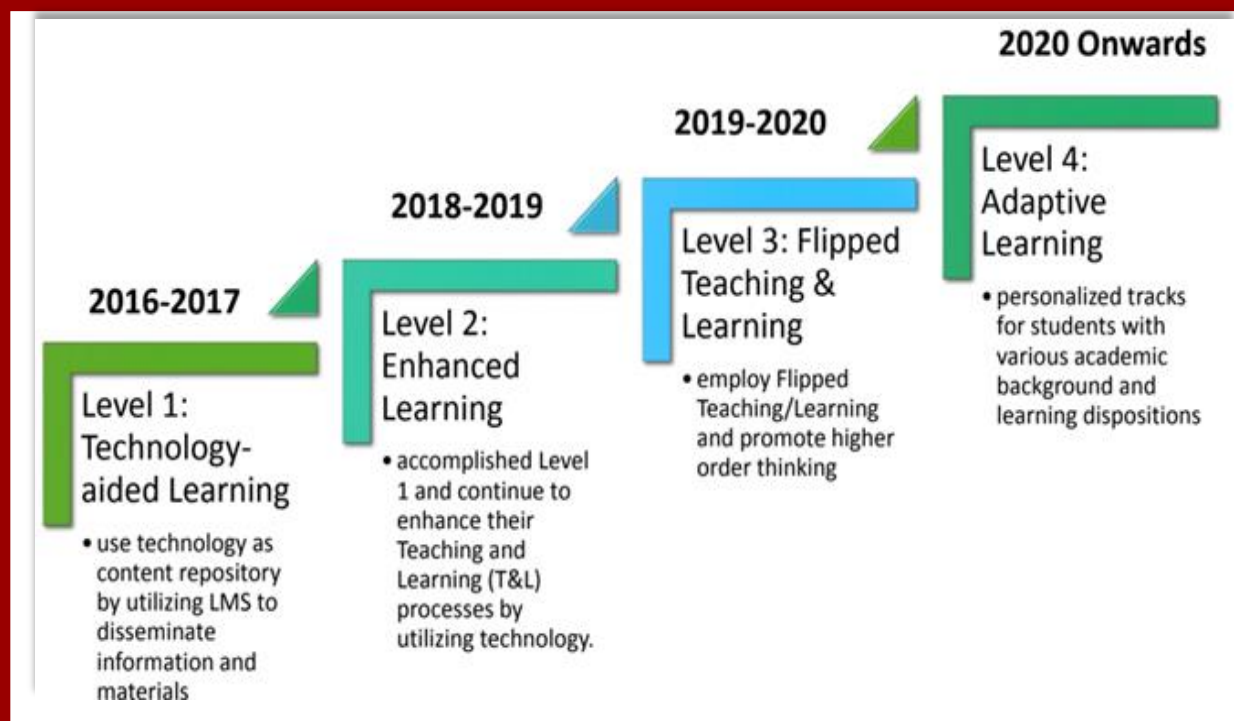
BL Implementation for Courses Category across College

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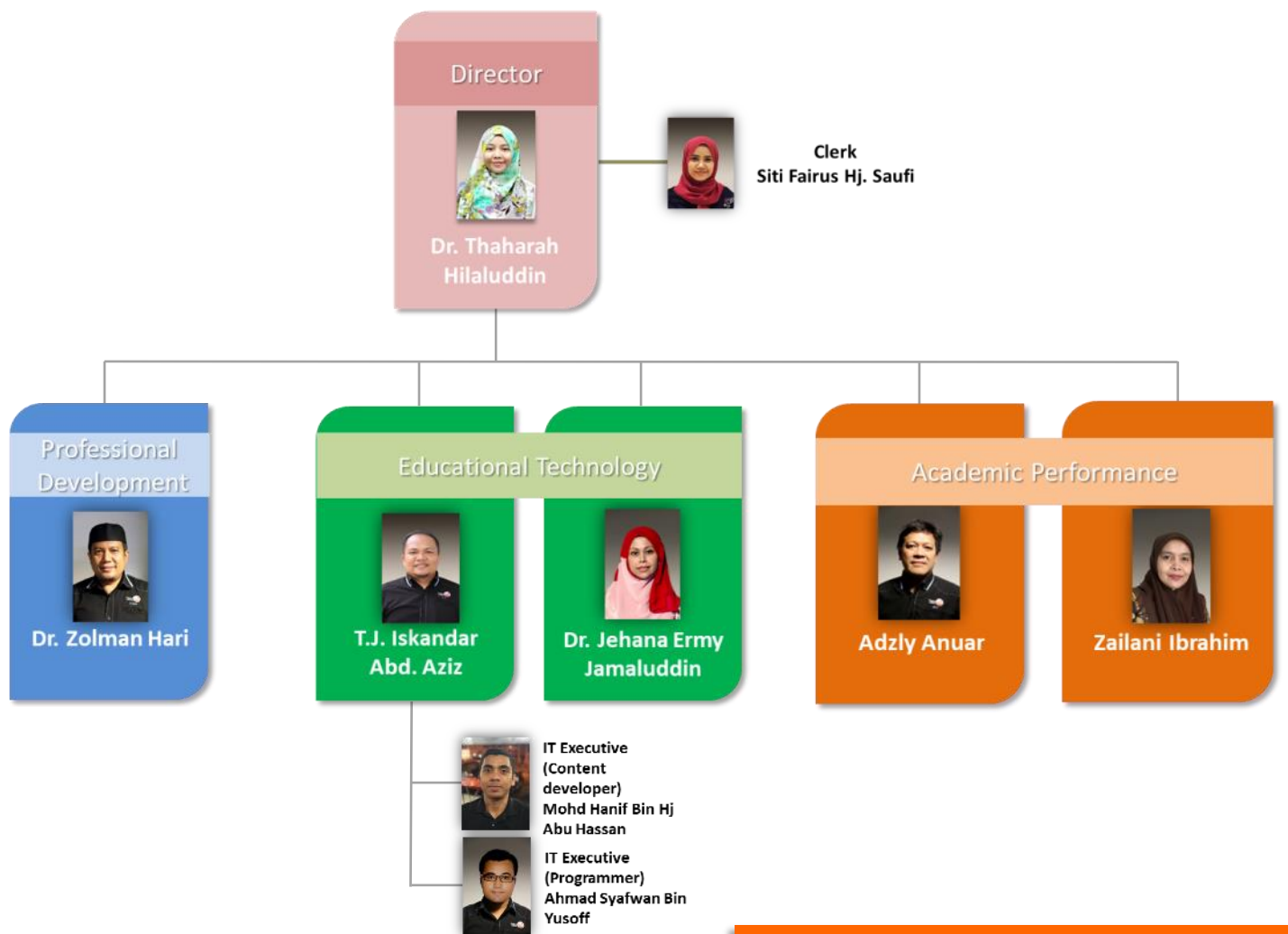
